Our side event, titled "Innovation for Human Rights: The Key Role of Technology," explores how scientific and technological progress can play a decisive role in promoting and protecting human rights. Target:

Event Format:

Live demonstrations of innovative technologies aimed at improving human rights will be organized.

How can science be used to solve human rights issues while respecting ethics?

Biotechnology and human rights: Can advances in biotechnology enhance or threaten human dignity?

Cybersecurity and data protection: How to ensure data security while preserving individual privacy rights?

Technology and access to education and health: How can technological innovations help ensure equitable access to education and health care?

This event is aimed at policymakers, academics, technology professionals, human rights advocates, civil society representatives and all those interested in the intersection of science, technology and human rights.

This side event will be a valuable opportunity to reflect on how science and technology can be used to promote and protect human rights in the modern era.
