Badges and access to Palais des Nations:	To facilitate access, screening and accreditation of participants and delegates, the Security and Safety Service would like to strongly recommend the following actions.  1. Pre-register Participants and delegates are advised to register online at least 48 hours in advance.  2. Pre-collect Once the registration approved, participants are requested to come and collect their accreditation badge in advance, from Wednesday, 20 November to Friday, 22 November as of 2 p.m., at the Identification Unit, located at the Palais des Nations - Pregny Gate. Additional opening hours are:  - Sunday, 24 November from 15.00-19.00  - Monday, 25 November through Wednesday, 27 November: 07.00 – 18.00  3. Bring Documentation In order to collect the accreditation badge and enter the Palais des Nations, please provide a copy of the registration confirmation (printed or on mobile device) and a valid ID (passport or ID card).  4. Arrive early On Monday 25 November, registered and accredited participants and delegates are invited to come as early as possible, from 07.00 hrs onwards. To avoid queuing it is highly recommended that badge-holders of the following categories: UN, States and speakers, should access the Palais via the gate of Nations (Place des Nations, by the chair and the flags).  5. Prepare for screening Two lanes will be reserved for Forum participants, one of them being a fast lane for delegates and speakers.		



	Participants and delegates are <b>strongly discouraged from bringing suitcases and large trolleys</b> , which will delay their screening process and which will not be stored by UNOG.
	Please read and follow the signs and listen to security instructions issued on site. Thank you for your understanding.
	On Monday, 25 November, as soon as <u>room XX</u> is full, Security will block its access. Participants are then advised to go to <u>room XIX</u> to follow the opening plenary on screen.
Customise your Forum programme	The Forum programme is made available using the Sched platform, which allows you to filter sessions based on your personal interests and to create your personal schedule of Forum sessions.
	Once your registration has been approved, you will receive, normally within a week, an individual invite to sign up for a free Sched account. (If you do not receive your invite, please, check your spam e-mail folder in case the invite got delivered there instead of your inbox.)
	By signing up, you will be able to create and access your personal agenda online, in the mobile app, and/or synchronize it to your personal calendar.
	On the settings page, you can update your profile, add a photo and brief information about yourself ("what people should talk to you about"), and make this information public or private at your own convenience (please note that is set in private mode by default)
	At a date closer to the Forum, the Forum organizers may make public the names and profiles of those participants who have created a public Sched profile.

	<ul> <li>On arrival at Geneva's international airport, a free public transportation pass can be obtained in the baggage claim area, lasting 80 minutes. This will enable you to reach your hotel.</li> <li>Participants staying at hotels, youth hostels or at campsites may receive a "Geneva Transport Card" free of charge. With this card, public transport in Geneva is free for the full duration of your stay.</li> </ul>		
Public Transport by Tram and Bus:	<ul> <li>Palais des Nations is accessible via several bus lines and a tramway.</li> <li>The Appia stop is nearest to the Pregny Gate and is served by buses 8, 28, F, V and Z.</li> <li>The Place des Nations stop is located 500 metres away from the Pregny Gate and is served by tram number 15 and buses 5, 8, 11, 14, 28, V, F, and Z.</li> </ul>		
	<u>From Geneva Cointrin airport</u> : by bus in 10-15 minutes. Take the bus n°28 towards Jardin Botanique and stop at <b>Appia</b> ; or take the bus n°5 towards Hôpital and stop at <b>Nations</b> .		
	<u>From Geneva Cornavin train station</u> : by bus or tram in 15-20 minutes. Take the tram n°15 towards Nations and stop at <b>Nations</b> , or take either the bus n°5 towards Aéroport and stop at <b>Nations</b> , or the bus n°8 towards OMS and stop at <b>Appia</b> .		
	Further information such as itineraries, timetables, fares, etc. is available on the site of the Transports publics genevois.		
	<ul> <li>Taxis: Taxis <u>cannot</u> enter the UN compound - participants will have to get off at Pregny Gate. Taxis are usually available around the clock.
